



## New Prepaid Mobile Telephony Services Surcharge Rates in Effect Beginning April 1, 2017

The Prepaid Mobile Telephony Services (MTS) surcharge rate for calendar year 2017 is 5.90 percent, *plus* any local charges that may apply to the city or county where the sale occurs. Beginning April 1, 2017, local charges for cities of Pomona, Sunnyvale, and Watsonville will apply and the surcharge rate for these cities will increase as listed below.
