<sup>1</sup>The city increased its existing 0.50 percent tax to 1.00 percent. Due to the rate change, the code used to report the old 0.50 percent tax (273/UKGT) will be replaced with a new code (480/UKHG) to report the 1.00 percent tax on returns for periods on or after April 1, 2017.

The validity of this tax is currently being challenged in a lawsuit, but it can be administered and collected while the lawsuit is ongoing subject to the special procedures set forth in the Transactions and Use Tax Law. This notice supersedes any notices previously issued by the California State Board of Equalization regarding this matter.
