

Welcome to our Property Tax Exemptions Nonprofit Virtual Seminar.

You will notice the Property Tax Exemptions Video for Nonprofit, Faith-based, Welfare and Veterans' Organizations. Brian Salmon, Property Appraiser at the Board of Equalization, will take you through this thirteen minute presentation that provides an introduction to California's property tax exemptions for eligible groups.

How to play the video:



: Pause/Play – Click the pause/play button to play the video. Click it again to pause the video.



: Slider – Place the cursor over the slider, then click and drag the slider to advance or rewind the video.

: Countdown Timer - To the right of the slider you will see a countdown timer that indicates the progress of the video in relation to the total length of the video.



: Volume – Place the cursor over the volume button and volume control slider will pop-up. Click and drag the slider up or down to adjust the volume.

Clicking the volume button will toggle between “mute” and maximum volume.



: Click the full screen button to view the video at full size. Click the button again to return to the previous view.



: Options – Click the options button for more You Tube options.
