1. Legislative Calendar

- a. May 31 (Friday): Last day for bills to be passed out of their house of origin.
- b. September 13 (Friday): Last day for each house to pass bills.
- c. October 13 (Sunday): Last day for Governor to sign or veto bills passed by the Legislature.

2. Committee Hearing Dates on BOE Bills of Interest

- a. Assembly Budget Subcommittee No. 4 on State Administration
 - i. April 30 BOE is not scheduled for this hearing.
 - ii. May 7 BOE is scheduled for this hearing.
- b. Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Subcommittee No. 4 on State Administration and General Government
 - i. May 2 BOE is not scheduled for this hearing.

3. Update on Legislative Bills

- a. ACA 2: Has not been assigned to a committee.
- b. AB 576: State Board of Equalization, Transfer of Duties
 - i. Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee hearing on April 22 Do Pass to Appropriations Committee (Hearing on May 1).
- c. AB 872: Property taxation change in ownership on parent to child transfer.
 - i. Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee hearing on April 22 Amended and re-referred to Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee.
- d. SB 577: State Board of Equalization, Administrative and Personnel Services.
 - i. Senate Government and Finance Committee hearing on April 24 Do Pass to Appropriations Committee.
 - ii. Hearing on May 6th
- e. SB 791: Property taxation valuation on certificated aircraft.
 - i. Senate Government and Finance Committee hearing on April 24 Do Pass to Appropriations Committee.
 - ii. Hearing on May 6th
 - iii. Urgency bill, so it must pass by $2/3^{\text{rd}}$ vote in both houses.
 - iv. Takes effect as soon as it is passed, signed, and chaptered.
 - v. Operational date is January 1, 2020.
 - vi. In case this passes, BOE staff is currently researching the resource needs required to meet the operational date.
