K4 Legislative, Research & Statistics Division Chief's Report

1. Legislative Calendar

- a. May 31: Last day for bills to be passed out of their house of origin.
- b. September 13: Last day for each house to pass bills.
- c. October 13: Last day for Governor to sign or veto bills passed by the Legislature.

2. Committee Hearing Dates on BOE Bills of Interest

a. No hearings have been scheduled in June concerning BOE related bills.

3. Update on Legislative Bills

- a. ACA 2: No change since being introduced on December 3, 2018.
- b. AB 576: State Board of Equalization, Transfer of Duties
 - i. February 14, 2019, introduced (odd-year)
 - ii. May 16th, the Appropriations Committee moved it to a two-year bill.
 - iii. January 31, 2020 is the last day for each house to pass bills introduced in that house in the odd-numbered year.
- c. AB 872: Property taxation change in ownership on parent to child transfer.
 - i. May 15th, Appropriations Committee ordered to Consent Calendar.
- d. SB 577: State Board of Equalization, Administrative and Personnel Services.
 - i. May 9th, Passed and ordered to the Assembly
- e. SB 196: Property taxes welfare exemption: community land trust
 - i. May 16th, Senate Appropriations Committee Ordered to third reading.
- f. SB 791: Property taxation valuation on certificated aircraft.
 - i. May 16th, Senate Appropriations Committee Ordered to third reading.
 - ii. Urgency bill, so it must pass by $2/3^{rd}$ vote in both houses.
 - iii. Takes effect as soon as it is passed, signed, and chaptered.
 - iv. Operational date is January 1, 2020.
 - v. In case this passes, BOE staff is currently researching the resource needs required to meet the operational date.
