Legislative Calendar

- July 12: Summer recess begins.
- August 12: Legislature reconvenes.
- September 13: Last day for each house to pass bills.
- October 13: Last day for Governor to sign or veto bills passed by the Legislature.

 - i) Referred to Appropriations suspense file. (6/24)
- 2) June 17: Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee
 - a) SB 364: Property tax - base year value factoring for veterans
 - i) Testimony only. No date has been scheduled.
 - b) SB 562: Property tax – disabled veterans' exemption
 - i) Testimony only. No date has been scheduled.
- 3) June 24: Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee
 - a) SB 577 (Hueso): BOE sponsored bill on administrative and personnel services.
 - i) Placed on Consent agenda.
 - b) SB 663 (Jones): Property tax – veterans' organization exemption
 - i) Passed to the Committee on Veterans Affairs.
 - c) SB 196 (Beall): Welfare Exemption, Community Land Trust.
 - i) Scheduled to be heard on Monday July 1.

Update on other Legislative Bills

1. ACA 2 (Nazarian): Assigned to the Assembly Revenue and Taxation committee.
 - a. It has not been scheduled for hearing.
2. AB 576 (Nazarian): State Board of Equalization: Transfer of duties.
 - a. No Change, moved this to a two-year bill.
3. AB 872 (Aguiar-Curry): Property taxation change in ownership on parent to child transfer.
 - a. Senate Governance and Finance Committee. No hearing has been set.
4. SB 791 (Senate Governance and Finance Committee): Property tax valuation: certificated aircraft.
 - a. Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee scheduled for July 1.

Mid-Session Legislative Statistics

- 89: Number of Bills BOE is tracking
 - 18: Property Tax
 - 13: Passed to 2nd House
 - 5: Remained in their House of Origin
 - 23: Alcoholic Beverage Tax and Tax on Insurers
 - 48: Administrative Bills
- 70% of the bills the BOE is tracking moved on to the 2nd House
- 30% of the remaining bills BOE is tracking remained in their House of Origin

 - a) No change from last month. Moved to two-year bill.
- 3) AB 872: Property taxation change in ownership on parent to child transfer.
 - a) May 29, Referred Senate Governance and Finance Committee.
- 4) SB 577: State Board of Equalization, Administrative and Personnel Services.
 - a) June 24th, Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee hearing
- 5) SB 196: Property taxes welfare exemption: community land trust
 - a) June 24th, Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee hearing
- 6) SB 791: Property taxation valuation on certificated aircraft.
 - a) On June 6th, referred to Assembly Revenue and Taxation Committee.

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
