LEGISLATIVE CALENDAR

- July 27: Legislature reconvenes from recess.
- Aug 31: Last day for each house to pass bills.
- Sept 30: Last day for the Governor to sign or veto bills.
- Nov 3: General Election
- Nov 30: Adjournment

BILLS OF INTEREST TO THE BOE

1. AB 2330 (Nazarian): Transfer of BOE duties
 - a. June 19: Last day for bills to pass in this house. Still listed as an active bill in Assembly Revenue and Taxation Cmte
2. ACA 2 (Nazarian): Abolish the BOE and create a new agency
 - a. June 25: Last day to qualify for Nov 3 ballot. Still listed as an active bill in Assembly Revenue and Taxation Cmte
3. SB 74 (Mitchell), Budget Act of 2020 Ch.6, Statutes of 2020
 - a. June 29: Approved by the Governor and filed and chaptered by the Secretary of State
 - b. No change to BOE's budget (\$30,790,000 / 192.6 PYs)
4. AB 3373 (Asm Rev & Tax Cmte): Property taxation: assessment appeals boards.
 - a. June 23: Referred to Senate Gov & Finance Cmte
5. ACA 11 (Mullins, Burke, Friedman, Gray, Mayes): The Home Protection for Seniors, Severely Disabled, Families, and Victims of Wildfire or Natural Disasters Act
 - a. July 1: Secretary of State, Chapter 31, Statues of 2020
 - b. Qualified Ballot Measure – Proposition 19

1. Initiative 1851 – Initial Split Roll Initiative
 - a. June 23: Withdrawn
2. Initiative 1870 – Replaced Int. 1851 Split Roll
 - a. Qualified Ballot Measure – Proposition 15
3. Initiative 1864 - Changes Requirements for Transferring Property Tax Base
 - a. July 1: Withdrawn
