Subject: Board Meeting, December 2022 – Item J – Administrative Session Assessors' Handbook Section 531, Residential Building Costs

I am requesting that <u>Assessors' Handbook Section 531</u>, *Residential Building Costs* (AH 531), be approved for publication. Revenue and Taxation Code section 401.5 requires that the Board issue to County Assessors information that will promote uniformity in assessed values throughout the state. Pursuant to that mandate, staff developed the January 2023 version of AH 531, which contains current cost data for residential buildings and manufactured homes.

Costs in this 2023 revision of AH 531 have increased due to continued demand for housing, including the materials and labor that are part of the cost structure. Appraisal judgement should be used to adjust for any market change that could affect costs after the publication date of AH 531.

Pursuant to the Board's authority under Revenue and Taxation Code section 401.5, I request that this item be placed on the Board's December 2022 Administrative Session Agenda for approval.
