### **CHIEF COUNSEL MATTERS**

Lawrence Lin, Tax Counsel, Legal Department, presented staff's request for authorization to commence the formal rulemaking process by publishing proposed amendment to Property Tax Rule 192, *Audit Selection*, to make Rule 192 consistent with Senate Bill (SB) 1498 (Stats. 2018, Ch. 467), which amended section 469 to provide County Assessors flexibility in meeting annual audit requirements (Exhibit 6.1).

MOTION: Ms. Lieber made a motion to approve authorization to commence the formal rulemaking process for Rule 192 as recommended by staff. The motion was seconded by Mr. Vazquez. The motion passed. Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran voted yes.

### **CONSENT AGENDA**

MOTION: Mr. Vazquez made a motion to adopt the consent agenda including the Board Meeting Minutes of May 23, 2023, and retirement resolution of Anita Hurtado (<u>Exhibit 6.2</u>), as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Gaines. The motion passed. Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran voted yes.

On behalf of the Board, Mary Cichetti, Clerk, Board Proceedings, read into the record a retirement resolution to Anita Hurtado, Office Technician, Taxpayers' Rights Advocate Office, extending the Board's sincere and grateful appreciation for her dedicated service to the State Board of Equalization and to the State of California. Members made complimentary remarks and provided their individual congratulations to Ms. Hurtado.

The Board recessed at 10:45 a.m. and reconvened at 10:48 a.m. with Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran present.

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#### **BOARD MEMBER MATTERS AND INITIATIVES**

Mr. Vazquez presented a proposal to establish a Property Tax Exemption Board Work Group on the Veterans', Disabled Veterans', and Homeowners' Exemptions to convene in collaboration with the County Assessors and other stakeholders starting on July 25-26, 2023 (<u>Exhibit 6.3</u>).

MOTION: Ms. Lieber made a motion to establish a Property Tax Exemption Board Work Group on the Veterans', Disabled Veterans', and Homeowners' Exemptions, as proposed by Mr. Vazquez. The motion was seconded by Mr. Vazquez. The motion passed. Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran voted yes.

Mr. Vazquez presented a proposal to establish a schedule to reconvene the Workforce Planning Board Work Group with the California Assessors' Association (CAA) and County Assessors from large, medium, and small counties to continue efforts to develop educational opportunities, recruitment, and training solutions for County Assessors' offices and the BOE, starting in July or August 2023 (Exhibit 6.4).

MOTION: Mr. Gaines made a motion to reconvene the Workforce Planning Board Work Group, as proposed by Mr. Vazquez. The motion was seconded by Mr. Schaefer. The motion passed. Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran voted yes.

Mr. Emran presented a proposal to establish a specialized unit within the State Board of Equalization's Legal Department to support and address the needs of small and mid-size County Assessors' offices to ensure legal matters elevated by them are handled expeditiously (Exhibit 6.5).

The Board received comment from the Hon. Kristine Lee, Kings County Assessor-Recorder-Clerk.

The Board agreed to discuss this matter further at the July Board Meeting.

Mr. Schaefer shared perspectives on the Board meeting agenda submission process concerning the May 23, 2023, Board Meeting Agenda Items 9 and 10, and the Governance Policy, Mission Statement and Board Meeting Reference Manual process, and presented a proposal for possible changes regarding limitations on Board Meeting Agenda submissions (Exhibit 6.6).

The Board agreed to review the current Governance Policy on the matter.

The Board recessed to go into a Board Work Group at 12:08 p.m. and reconvened at 12:19 p.m. with Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran present.

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The Board recessed at 12:20 p.m. and reconvened at 1:24 p.m. with Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran present.

Stowers, Executive Director, reported that the Counties of Alpine, Colusa, Humboldt, Inyo, Lake, Lassen, Placer, Plumas, San Benito, Tehama, and Tulare have received time extensions to complete and submit their 2023 Local Assessment Rolls, pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code section 155.

Lisa Renati, Chief Deputy Director, reported on the status of operational priorities.

Lisa Thompson, Taxpayers' Rights Advocate, provided an update on the workload of the Taxpayers' Rights Advocate Office (Exhibit 6.7).

David Yeung, Deputy Director, Property Tax Department, reported on the status of pending and upcoming projects, activities, and departmental issues.

Glenna Schultz, Principal Property Appraiser, County-Assessed Properties Division, reported on the status of Letters to Assessors (<u>Exhibit 6.8</u>), and the Appraisal Training and Certification Program.

Michelle Cruz, Principal Property Appraiser, State-Assessed Properties Division, reported on the status of pending and upcoming projects and activities for the Division.

Ted Angelo, Chief, Legislative, Research & Statistics Division, provided an update on administrative, and program related legislative bills impacting the BOE (Exhibit 6.9).

MOTION: Mr. Emran made a motion to direct the Executive Director to report on the 2023-24 State Budget at the July meeting or when the final budget is in print. The motion was seconded by Mr. Gaines. The motion passed. Mr. Vazquez, Ms. Lieber, Mr. Gaines, Mr. Schaefer, and Mr. Emran voted yes.
