I would like to express my appreciation of the proposal submitted by Controller Cohen to expand the legal team of the Board of Equalization (BOE) and assist small and mid-sized County Assessors with legal inquiries. Similarly, I would also like to commend the BOE for exploring strategic courses of action that may allow our administrations to further benefit the property owners of California.

Although the County Assessors consider the current legal team with the BOE to be a valued resource, employing a specialized unit may provide added support for our shared commitment of delivering fair and equitable assessments. As Ms. Cohen mentioned in her proposal, small and mid-sized counties, at times, lack the resources to obtain legal counsel with expertise in certain areas of property valuation. Consequently, the Assessors rely on each other for knowledge, mutual experiences and/or sharing of expert staff. As Ms. Cohen also pointed out, occasionally Assessors must independently research and make individual determinations.
