On Her Retirement

WHEREAS, Glenna Schultz, Principal Property Appraiser in the County-Assessed Properties Division of the Property Tax Department, retired on November 1, 2024, after forty-two years of outstanding and meritorious service to the State of California and the California State Board of Equalization (BOE); and

WHEREAS, Glenna began her career with the California State Board of Equalization on October 8, 1982, as a Stenographer in the Assessment Standards Division (now known as the County-Assessed Properties Division) in Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, as a result of diligent work and demonstrated ability, she advanced to positions of increasing responsibility, first to the position of Program Technician I on January 1, 1986, with the Property Tax Department's Southern California Sampling Team located in Orange, then to Program Technician II on April 1, 1987. Next, she was appointed to the position of Junior Property Appraiser on January 1, 1990, then to Assistant Property Appraiser in 1991, before transferring to the Real Property Technical Services Unit in Sacramento on August 31, 1992, and promoting to Associate Property Appraiser on November 20, 1992; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of her outstanding leadership skills and proven professionalism, Glenna became a subject matter expert in the assessment of real property such as change in ownership and new construction and served as the Property Tax Department's Annotations Coordinator, Legislative Coordinator, and Rules Coordinator. Her expertise and contributions earned her appointment to Senior Specialist Property Appraiser on February 10, 2006, and a role teaching change in ownership and new construction workshops to BOE staff and various change in ownership classes for the California Assessor's Administrative Services Association; and

WHEREAS, Glenna's sharp mind and attention to detail enabled her to create new or improved procedures that enhanced the effectiveness of the division's operations, which led her to be appointed as the Principal Property Appraiser of the Assessment Services Unit on July 9, 2021; and

WHEREAS, throughout her many years of service, Glenna has served the people of this state with fairness and dedication, therefore:
