Notice of Interested Parties Meeting**

The State Board of Equalization (BOE) Legislative and Research Division, Sales and Use Tax Department, and Property and Special Taxes Department invite you to attend an interested parties meeting to discuss legislative proposals the Board may consider for this year's legislative session. Before the proposal is presented at the Legislative Committee meeting, we would like to provide stakeholders the opportunity to discuss the issues and present any suggested changes or comments.

Proposal 1 – Authorize the Board of Equalization (BOE) to enter into a reciprocal agreement with the United States Department of the Treasury's Bureau of the Fiscal Service (BFS) to collect delinquent tax debt owed to the BOE by offset of federal vendor payments. In return, allow the federal government to collect delinquent federal non-tax debt by offset of BOE tax refund and vendor payments.

Proposal 2 - Impose sales tax on a person's retail sales of vehicles, when that person fails to hold a dealer's license required under the Vehicle Code at the time of sale.

Proposal 3 – Specify the effective dates related to state fuel tax rates when triggered by a reduction or elimination of the federal fuel taxes.

Proposal 4 – Increase the reinstatement fee on motor vehicle fuel, use fuel and diesel fuel accounts from \$50 to \$100 to adjust for inflation and be consistent with both the Sales and Use Tax Law and the Cigarette and Tobacco Products Licensing Act Law.
