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6	MS. CICHETTI: Then we're going to continue on
7	to Board Member Matters; Item L2, Board Member
8	Initiatives; L2a, Agenda Structure Update.
9	Discuss recommended options for Board
10	Member Board Meeting agenda template and procedures
11	for Board modification and approval, presented by
12	Chair Vazquez.
13	MR. VAZQUEZ: Thank you.
14	Members, as an elected State body, we are
15	required to allow members of the public to attend and
16	participate as fully as possible in our discussions and
17	decision-making processes on every item.
18	And our agenda notice requirements are based
19	on the state policy that the people must be informed so
20	they can keep patrol over their government.
21	Ms. Stowers and I and my staff worked over the
22	past month on how to modernize the current Public Agenda
23	Notice, looking at examples of other elected bodies.
24	We are jointly proposing today the changes set
25	forth in this in my memo linked to this item that

- 1 would add further clarity to the public we serve.
- I'm going to ask Ms. Stowers to present the
- 3 new agenda template. But we are open to your input and
- 4 any additional suggestions you may have after her
- 5 presentation.
- 6 MR. VAZQUEZ: Ms. Stowers is coming up.
- 7 MS. STOWERS: Good afternoon, Members.
- 8 Yvette Stowers, Executive Director.
- 9 The proposed new agenda template, it is
- 10 attached to the agenda. It is Exhibit A. And we're
- just changing the order of some things, first of all.
- We will start our meeting as we normally do
- 13 with the Call to Order. And after that, and the pledge,
- 14 we will take up Public Comments on Matters Not on the
- 15 Agenda, bringing that up to the front of the agenda so
- 16 that those who have an interest can speak as soon as
- 17 possible, believing that's the best way, most
- 18 transparent and taxpayer-friendly method.
- Then we'll move on, and we would have this as
- 20 a standing item, it will be our Consent Agenda. And,
- 21 like we currently have, and it will be generally
- 22 adoption of the Board Meeting minutes. That's how, if
- 23 we were looking at our March meeting, that would have
- 24 been on there.
- 25 And then we will follow that with our Tax

- 1 Program Matters. That would be our audits, our escape
- 2 assessments, our value setting. Everything that we do
- 3 statutory or by the Constitution, that will follow
- 4 there.
- 5 Chief Counsel Matters, that heading will
- 6 appear on the agenda. And when it's scheduled, it will
- 7 be detailed. For example, if Chief Counsel was going to
- 8 present on rulemaking, it would say "Rulemaking."
- 9 And then we go to the Executive Director's
- 10 Report, and it will be our standing report, starting
- 11 with my report, and then Report on Operational
- 12 Priorities, the Taxpayer Rights Advocate Report, the
- 13 Property Tax Department Report, which will have more
- 14 detailed reports behind Mr. Yeung.
- Then we do our Leg. Report, and then we always
- 16 follow with our Board Member Matters and Initiatives.
- 17 And this is where, like today, you would have your
- 18 special presentations, anything that you guys would like
- 19 to take up.
- 20 And then we will have a standing heading of
- 21 Public Policy Hearings, where it is sometimes, as you've
- 22 discussed something as a Board Member matter, you may
- 23 decide that you would like to have a Public Policy
- 24 Hearing on that item. Or we may be receiving a lot of
- 25 questions and calls on a particular topic, and decide

- 1 that we would like to have a Public Policy Hearing so
- 2 that we can discuss the matter in a transparent way.
- And then finally we will close. If there's
- 4 Closed Session, we will go into Closed Session, and we
- 5 explain why. And finally an adjournment.
- 6 So this is our proposal to streamline our
- 7 agenda and make it more easier for the public to know
- 8 the business of the Board of Equalization, and know when
- 9 they would have an opportunity to speak, and to speak
- 10 upfront of the agenda.
- I thank Chair Vazquez and his team for working
- with me and my team on preparing the proposal.
- Any questions?
- MR. VAZQUEZ: Seeing no comments --
- MR. GAINES: Just a comment.
- MR. VAZQUEZ: Oh, sure. Go ahead.
- 17 MR. GAINES: I like what I'm hearing. It
- 18 sounds a lot more logical and simple for us, but also,
- 19 more importantly, our constituents.
- MR. VAZQUEZ: We're hoping, yeah, it would be
- 21 a little more user-friendly.
- MR. GAINES: Yeah. That's great. Thank you.
- MR. VAZQUEZ: Oh, yes. Deputy Controller, go
- 24 ahead.
- 25 MR. EMRAN: Thank you, Executive Director. I

- 1 appreciate your initiative here, and the Chairman for
- 2 bringing this forward.
- I also do really appreciate you studying and
- 4 looking at what other State agencies are doing in order
- 5 for us to better streamline our processes to make it
- 6 more user-friendly, and enhance participation from the
- 7 public, as long as being easy to follow.
- 8 So kudos to you and the entire agency.
- 9 Thank you.
- 10 MS. STOWERS: I have to give credit to the
- 11 ladies to the left.
- MR. VAZQUEZ: I'd like to entertain a motion
- 13 that we move this item and approve the new agenda.
- MS. LIEBER: Move.
- MR. GAINES: Second.
- MR. VAZQUEZ: It's been moved by our
- 17 Vice Chair and seconded by Member Gaines.
- Do we have any -- we don't have any written
- 19 comment on this, do we, Ms. Cichetti?
- MS. CICHETTI: No, we do not have any written
- 21 comment, and no one in the audience to make a
- 22 presentation. But let's go out to the AT&T moderator.
- MR. VAZQUEZ: Let's see.
- MS. CICHETTI: AT&T moderator, can you please
- let us know if there's anyone on the line who would like

- 1 to make a public comment regarding this item.
- 2 AT&T MODERATOR: Once again, if you'd like to
- 3 make a public comment on this item, press one, zero on
- 4 your phone's keypad at this time.
- 5 And we have no callers responding in queue.
- 6 MS. CICHETTI: Thank you.
- 7 So we have a motion to adopt the new agenda
- 8 template as presented.
- 9 The motion was presented by Vice Chair Lieber
- 10 and second by Mr. Gaines.
- 11 Let's take roll.
- 12 Chair Vazquez.
- MR. VAZQUEZ: Aye.
- MS. CICHETTI: Vice Chair Lieber.
- MS. LIEBER: Aye.
