PROPERTY TAX COMMITTEE WORK PLANS FOR 2000

February 3, 2000

TO COUNTY ASSESSORS AND INTERESTED PARTIES:

This letter provides information regarding the Property Tax Committee work plans for January through December 2000. The information provided is not a formal agenda for the committee; rather, it is a summary of the committee's plans for dealing with significant property tax issues for the year 2000. Enclosed are two calendars containing (tentative) key dates in the process, one by subject matter and the other by month.

In addition to matters scheduled to go before the Property Tax Committee in 2000, rewrites of Assessors' Handbook Section 511, Assessment of Manufactured Homes, to be combined with Section 512, Assessment of Manufactured Home Parks, are projected to start during 2000. Also projected to start during the year is redrafting of the taxable possessory interest rules in the California Code of Regulations, and a redrafting of the Assessors' Handbook Section 510, Assessment of Possessory Interests. Although these items are not scheduled to come before the committee until calendar year 2001, staff has also included key 2000 dates relating to them on the two enclosed calendars.

The dates listed are subject to change depending on the needs of the participants. New issues could also arise and affect the schedule.

Property Tax Committee meetings (unless noted otherwise) will be held at Board of Equalization headquarters in Sacramento. Most other meetings will also be held in Sacramento, but alternative locations may be selected depending on the needs of participants.
